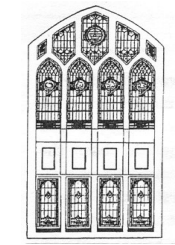

From the Associate Pastor for Music and Worship —

It continues to be a busy summer. . .in the midst of moving, Charles and I are trying to maintain our prior music and ministry commitments for the month of July. When you receive this newsletter, the Lasker Summer Music Festival will be in full swing with participants coming from Maryland, Virginia, and Illinois. Charles and I always look forward to hosting fellow musicians as we spend time together in Christian fellowship and devotions, music-making, and service to the community through the sharing of music, and we hope that you'll be able to join us for one or more of the concerts.

On July 11th we will be sharing some of our LSMF music-making in worship, and then Charles and I will be flying off to Birmingham, AL, that afternoon to attend the annual conference of The Hymn Society in the United States and Canada. It's always a song-filled week with 400-500 participants who love to sing. We gather each evening for special hymn-based worship services and then sing throughout the day at workshops and plenary sessions on music of the church. Church musicians, organists, pianists, choir directors, ministers, laity, hymnologists, hymn writers, professors of church music, and graduate students seem to find their way there and the fellowship is wonderfully rich because of the ecumenism and spirit of humility. This summer the theme is songs of peace and justice so Charles and I suggested that our friend Stefan Waligur be included during the week, which turned into an invitation for him to lead an evening prayer song service at the close of each day. The Hymn Society has become a family for us over the years and this year should prove to continue that. Not only will we be able to worship with new and old friends, but Charles and I will also get to learn more about his biological family while we're there. In May Charles was asked to play for a workshop that a gentleman named Richard Hulan will be leading. In their correspondence about the workshop, they learned that they most likely are cousins in some fashion. Isn't life fun with all the wonderful connections?!
