- 3 As for parking, park where you can find a spot. There will be significant space in our driveway and along the street. There may be additional space nearby but I need to ask first!
- 4 From the driveway side, you will enter the house on the second floor. The entrance is under the carport. Someone will greet you and help you navigate the two small steps at the door, if needed. Once inside, there are no steps on the main level. There is one bathroom upstairs and two bathrooms downstairs.
