

✘ Food Pantry Volunteers Needed

Our church is responsible for staffing the Ahoskie food pantry every Friday. Since some of our volunteers can no longer serve due to aging issues or illness, we are in need of more volunteers.

Volunteers may serve monthly or bi-monthly. Besides distributing food boxes to clients at the food pantry, responsibilities include arrival at 9:15 am, recording temperatures in refrigerators and freezers, shelving food items, and preparing boxes for clients.

The food pantry serves clients Monday through Friday from 9:30 am to 12 noon. If you would like to volunteer, please contact Vicky Overman, FBC food pantry coordinator, at 396-5729.

Also, the *Backpack Ministry* of the food pantry is in need of volunteers to gather as needed to pack lunch backpacks for students in the Hertford County school system. Currently, under pandemic conditions, 75 backpacks are picked up each week by school personnel. If you would like to volunteer for this ministry, please contact Margaret Winn at (252) 209-1495.

✘ Food Drive for Britton Ministries

Each fall Baptist Children's Homes of NC hosts a food drive for each of their campuses. We have the opportunity to support our local children's home, *Britton Ministries*, by purchasing gift cards for local grocery stores. From mid-October to mid-November you're invited to bring or mail a gift card to the church. In mid-November we'll deliver all gift cards as a fitting way to offer God thanksgiving for this critical ministry in our community. *Britton Ministries* helps single mothers in north eastern North Carolina by providing a structured transitional environment that promotes relational development between mother and child as well as needed resources to help the family regain control of their lives.
