From the Associate Pastor



Under the leadership of beloved ministers of music, organists, and pianists, a strong music ministry has K been a hallmark of First Baptist Church

of Ahoskie for much of its 200+ year history. And for the past four years, Buddy Hyatt helped us continue that tradition as he served as Music Associate/Organist. Buddy concluded his ministry with us on September 5, therefore, with gratitude, we offer our thanks and wish him well.

Upon learning of Buddy's resignation, many of you have asked, "How long do you think it will take for us to find another organist." My answer remains the same: I have no idea, but I'm hopeful.

We will make connections and get the word out. We will pray and hope for a new partner in ministry who has the musical gifts we need to continue the fine music tradition we've always had at FBCA. In the meantime, I remain grateful for the ministry of Bland Baker who is ever faithful and more than able to help us press on. Thank you, Bland.

Speaking of pressing on, our intergenerational ensemble, Chairo, begins rehearsals this Sunday, September 16. Chairo will meet each week at 4:00 pm in the choir room. Students in grades 6-12 as

well as adults of all ages are invited to come and sing. We sing praise & worship music as well as global church music. Chairo is a transliteration of the Greek word for "to rejoice."

Then at 5:00 pm, beginning September 16, I will lead a Sanctuary Choir rehearsal for any singers who would like to sing in the Sanctuary Choir but are not able to rehearse on Wednesday evenings.

All of our choir rehearsals are filled with beautiful music-making and lots of joyful laughter. Music and laughter, what better "medicine?" Come join us!
