# Thoughts on Full Time

By now every member of FBC Ahoskie should have received a letter from our deacons proposing I transition from part-time pastor to full-time pastor. Per the letter, a church-wide discussion is scheduled for this Sunday, December 23<sup>rd</sup>, at 9:30am and then our church membership will vote on this recommendation on Sunday, December 30<sup>th</sup>. In preparation for the discussion and vote, allow me to offer my thoughts about this development.

I have sensed a tug to move in this direction for a while now. In fact, I have had conversations with a few members of our church leadership in the past about transitioning from part-time pastor to full-time pastor. One immediate obstacle was the realization that our church cannot match the combined income I make between Chowan University and First Baptist Ahoskie. I confess, with disappointment in myself, that this reality caused me pause.

Until now, that is.

Recently, my eyes were opened to a handful of professional and personal realities. First, my heart is in our church. Of course, I continue to find it rewarding to share my knowledge with undergraduate students. And I may still teach a class in the future, if the opportunity arises. However, the prospect of devoting my full energies to our collective work here in Ahoskie grows more and more attractive each day.

Through the years, I have strived to lead each congregation I have served to develop a strong church culture. My desire was always to serve God, through Christ, with a group of people who give a high priority to the church. In the past, the evidence suggests I failed in this endeavor. Our

church, however, feels different. I do not mean to suggest that we have arrived. However, as I interact with you, I get the impression that more and more of our people are trying to give the church higher priority than they have in the past. This excites me. And this makes me dream about our future growth possibilities – both missional and numerical.

Lou Ann is very much in favor of this move. While all is well now, she believes my current role as both professor and pastor is not sustainable. I see her point as both positions require a significant amount of time and effort. It is worth remembering that we developed our current pastoral model not because FBC Ahoskie could not maintain a full-time pastor; rather we developed this model to accommodate my initial desires. And I am thankful for your patience with me.

The tug has now become so strong that I believe the time has arrived for our church to have, once again, a traditional full-time pastor. What do you think?


