Capital Campaign Update

Your Capital Campaign Committee wants to provide you with this update on Phase I, the Preservation portion of our Capital Campaign launched in 2017 and scheduled for completion now.

At the end of 2017, we had gifts and pledges totaling almost \$354,000. At the end of 2018 we had:

Total deposits: \$336,419.93 Total expenses: \$167,970.33 Balance: \$168,449.60

Because we are aware of pledges that were overpaid, there is roughly \$30,000 in pledges still outstanding. We can all be pleased with the generosity of this congregation thus far and we are hopeful that all pledged amounts will be received soon.

The following Preservation projects of Phase I have been completed or are nearing completion:

- •Repaired roof over the sanctuary
- •Replaced the West Street sidewalk
- •Paved the West Street parking lot
- •Purchased adjoining property on North Street
- •Demolished house and cleared an adjoining lot purchased earlier
- •Painted, caulked, or replaced deteriorating windows
- •Power washed the exterior of the church building
- •Improved the extension of metal handrails on front steps
- Employed *Church Interiors* of High Point to evaluate our space needs and to provide professional expertise regarding options for improvements in our sanctuary, fellowship hall and kitchen.

We are excited about providing you with more information regarding our planning for Phase II (Preparation) in the coming months!
