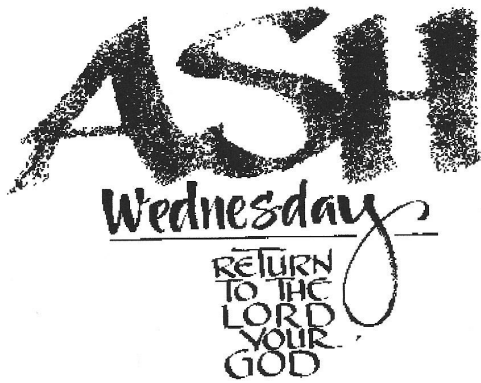

Join us in the sanctuary as we begin the Season of Lent together. As we gather for worship, we'll engage in a time of confession, and observe the tradition of the imposition of ashes.

Ash Wednesday is always 46 days before Easter Sunday and marks the beginning of the Lenten season. Lent is traditionally a 40-day period — a reference to the time Jesus spent being tempted in the desert — that seeks to prepare the heart of the believer for the solemn remembrance of Jesus' death. It concludes and is followed by a joyous Easter Sunday celebration of the resurrection of Christ.
