

#### **Prayer Partners for School Year**

A minister friend shared a ministry idea that I think could work well at FBCA, a Prayer Partners ministry which builds relationships between children/teens and adults.



At the beginning of the new school year, school-age children and/or teens are invited to be paired with an adult with whom they will commit to pray daily for one another

from September to May. The Prayer Partners ministry begins with a meal at which the partners meet one another and exchange information such as mailing addresses, phone numbers, birthdays, hobbies, and favorite foods. My friend said that some prayer partners met with one another occasionally throughout the school year, others did not. It's really up to those involved how they'd like to be prayer partners to one another. But the main commitment is to pray DAILY for one another.

I'd like for us to give this ministry a try for the 2019-2020 school year. If you'd like to participate, please let me know. If you need more information before you decide, please ask. We'll begin on Sunday, September 15, with a breakfast in the fellowship hall at 9:00 am. I hope you'll give it a try.
