Transfiguration Sunday the Last Epiphany

We began the Season of Epiphany with the story of Jesus' baptism where God affirms Jesus' divinity by proclaiming, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." (Matthew 3:13-17) This Sunday, February 23, we conclude the season with the story of Jesus' transfiguration. (Matthew 17:1-9), where God again affirms Jesus's divinity with a similar proclamation: "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!" As we gather for worship on this last Sunday of Epiphany, let us come ready to celebrate the divinity of Jesus, and be ready indeed to listen to him.

With our Ash Wednesday service on February 26 we begin the season of Lent. To help us on our Lenten journey, I will be leading a book study on Mondays, offering two meeting times in the hope that doing so will help more people participate. We begin the Season of Lent dining and worshiping together. After enjoying a meal in our fellowship hall, we'll move to the sanctuary where we'll engage in a time of reflection and confession as we observe the tradition of the imposition of ashes.

Ash Wednesday falls 46 days before Easter Sunday and marks the beginning of the Lenten season. Lent is traditionally a 40-day period — a reference to the time Jesus spent being tempted in the desert — that seeks to prepare the heart for the solemn remembrance of Jesus' death. It concludes and is followed by a joyous Easter Sunday celebration of the resurrection of Christ.
