Capital Campaign Update



On February 20th, our deacons voted unanimously to accept the recommendations from the capital campaign committee in relation to sanctuary renovations as well as the construction of a green space on our North Street lot. Therefore, on Wednesday March 4th, 2020, we will have a church-wide discussion at 6pm in our fellowship hall. Our deacons will recommend that our church move forward with these two projects. And, our capital campaign committee will present their recommendations to the gathered church body. There will not be a vote at this meeting; there will simply be the recommendation, the presentation, and the discussion.

The vote is scheduled for Sunday, March 22nd, 2020 before morning worship. All church members are invited to vote during this brief business meeting. There will be no discussion on the March 22nd, just the vote.

The church membership is invited to ask, even before March 4th, any questions you may have. If you would like to start the discussion before the March 4th meeting, please speak with anyone from the capital campaign committee or the pastor.
