On Sunday, May 24, we concluded the season of Eastertide which covers the fifty days from Easter Sunday up to the Day of Pentecost. This Sunday's high and holy day is, therefore, Pentecost Sunday.

On May 31st we celebrate the birth of the Christian Church and the gift of the Holy Spirit, promised by Christ to be with us to comfort and convict, guide and instruct. We'll hear the Pentecost story as found in Acts 2:1-21, and sing hymns and songs about the Holy Spirit and the role it plays in helping the church be the church.



Normally. we would gather wearing the colors of fire . . . vellows reds. and oranges . . . and, of course, you may still do that at home. Additionally, you have flowers of Pentecost colors in your yard, add a vase of them to your athome worship space. Use fabric and/or candles

to dress up your worship space. And if you really want to get into the Pentecost spirit, bake a cake, decorated it in Pentecost colors, and write, "Happy Birthday, Church," on it! However you choose to celebrate the day, may it be a day of meaningful worship, offering thanks to God for the gifts of His Spirit and His church.
