## The Christian Year—Trinity Sunday

Last Sunday, May 31, we observed Pentecost Sunday, a day which celebrates the birth of the Christian Church and the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is fitting then, that on the following Sunday we observe Trinity Sunday. On this day we give thanks for the Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
