GUIDELINES

We HIGHLY encourage you to continue to listen to the radio or livestream Facebook if you are VUL-NERABLE.

If you plan to attend a worship service, please make your reservation by calling the church office as soon as possible. A firm number is needed to ensure appropriate safety measures are in place.

There will be no Sunday school or nursery at this time.

Where to Enter — Enter the church at the West Street door. A greeter will be there to guide you. All other doors will be locked.

Upon entering the building your temperature will be taken, and there will be a list of questions for you to answer. Hand sanitizer will be available. You are required to wear a mask over your mouth and nose. Masks will be available at the West St. door.
