## GUIDELINES

We HIGHLY encourage you to continue to listen to the radio or livestream Facebook if you are VULNERABLE.

If you plan to attend a worship service, please make your reservation by calling the church office as soon as possible. A firm number is needed to ensure appropriate safety measures are in place.

There will be no Sunday school or nursery at this time.

**Where to Enter** — Enter the church at the West Street door. A greeter will be there to guide you. All other doors will be locked.

Upon entering the building your temperature will be taken, and there will be a list of questions for you to answer. Hand sanitizer will be available. You are required to wear a mask over your mouth and nose. Masks will be available at the West St. door.

**First Floor Areas** — The bathrooms on the first floor, the kitchen, library, fellowship hall and entire preschool hall past the elevator will be roped off. The elevator and the stairs by the West Street entrance are the only areas to be used.

**Second Floor Areas** — The second floor will be roped off just past the men's bathroom. There will be no access to Sunday School rooms or the offices except the main office which will remain open to monitor security cameras. The choir room will be taped off as well.

The 2nd floor ladies' restroom near the choir room, and the 2nd floor men's restroom by the elevator will be the only available restrooms. The vestibule stairs will also be roped off downstairs.

**Third Floor Areas** — The third floor will be completely roped off.

In case of an emergency you may break through the roped off areas to exit.

Elevator use is limited to one person at a time unless you are family. There will be signs for social distancing as you wait.

Offering plates will be located at the sanctuary doors. You may leave your offering as you enter or exit.

Designated sanctuary seating will be marked to ensure social distancing. All other seats will be
