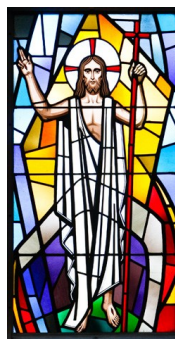

Mission service today takes many forms for CBF field personnel. Greg Smith provides immigration legal services to migrants and refugees as a way of sharing Christ's love and concern for them. When immigrant populations were disproportionately affected by Covid-19, he made the decision to provide pro bono services to all of his 62 clients. And during December, each local client family received a basket of fresh fruits and vegetables, and gifts for the children.

As we help people with work permits, residency, or citizenship, we often discover other needs: hunger, crisis assistance, or simply the need for someone to listen and pray with them.
