From the Deacon Chair

On June 6, 2021 we were called into church conference to vote on the question of changing the time of our morning worship service. This followed a Wednesday night question and answer session on May 29 in the church fellowship hall. Based on the desire of the deacons to let the people decide the vote margin the first question on the ballot was:

Should a congregational vote on moving the Sunday morning worship service time from the existing 11 AM schedule, to a different time, require at least a favorable sixty percent (60%) majority vote of those voting in person or by absentee ballot, to be effective? YES_____NO____

This passed **81 to 50** in favor of requiring a super majority of those voting to change the time of our morning worship. The membership expressed a desire for the 60% supermajority.

The second question was:

Should FBC Ahoskie move its Sunday morning worship time from 11AM to 10AM, and its SS time from 10AM to 9 AM, beginning on a Sunday jointly approved by the Bd. of Deacons and the Pastor? YES_____NO____

The vote on this question was **50 votes** to maintain the time and **67 votes** to change the time. This vote did not reach a supermajority or 60 % of the votes cast. A supermajority would have required 70 votes in favor of a change.

At the June Deacons meeting the deacons, after discussion and earnest evaluation of the vote taken, decided that because the vote was very close but did not pass we would make no changes at this time.

The deacons decided to revisit the question in the future for more evaluation. The constant desire of the deacons is to do the very best thing for the church at any given time. It is our hope that these facts will help everyone understand the vote and the results of it.

Continue to pray for enthusiastic attendance each Sunday regardless of the time and continued growth for our church.


