50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Presentations Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, May 15<sup>th</sup>




The dates have been set for the 50th anniversary presentations of the Christian folk musical, *Celebrate Life*. Whether you've never sung
