There is some curiosity about the number of people we had for Easter worship (April 17). So, I thought I would let you know what our numbers have been recently for Sunday morning worship. We appear to be returning to where we were pre-Covid. Though, we are not there yet.

March 6 = 142 people March 13 = 184 people March 20 = 196 people March 27 = 165 people *** average for March = 171.75 people *** April 3 = 146 people April 10 (Palm Sunday) = 215 people April 17 (Easter Sunday) = 271 people


Because our Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday participation numbers are so good, we simply need 168 people in worship this Sunday to average 200 people in worship for the month of April. Will you do your part to make certain we exceed 168 people in worship this Sunday (4-24-2022)?

The Sunday after Easter is often referred to as low Sunday. One reason for this designation is because usually there are a lot less people in worship than there was for Easter Sunday. If you are a member of FBC Ahoskie, will you make as much effort to be present for worship this Sunday (April 24) as you did for Easter Sunday? Let's do our best to avoid low Sunday. If you are an inactive member, will you return to worship this Sunday? We need all inactive members back in our congregation making their unique contributions to the advancement of the Kingdom of God here in Ahoskie and beyond.

I strongly believe with high commitment levels from our church membership, as well as the numerous visitors we have with us now, our church could average 200 people in worship on Sunday mornings. The numbers above indicate we have this potential. Remember: a growing and vibrant church requires God's movement in our midst and hard work from our people. There is no question that God is at work in our congregation. We continue to have new people join our church. We baptize on a regular basis. We reach out to the needy in our back yard and beyond. Have you seen all the children that contribute so much joy to the life of our fellowship! God is doing God's thing. Now, we must invest the necessary hard work. Easter was so good this year. Let's build on that momentum going forward!
