The Season of Epiphany

Following the 12th day of Christmas, the church ushers in the Season of Epiphany. The official beginning of Epiphany is January 6, but since this date may fall on any day of the week, we celebrate Epiphany Sunday on the Sunday closest to that date.



"As with most aspects of the Christian Year, Epiphany has theological significance. The term epiphany means 'to show' or 'to make known' or even 'to reveal.' The Wise Men or Magi who brought gifts to the child Jesus were the first Gentiles to acknowledge Jesus as 'King'

and so were the first to 'show' or 'reveal' Jesus to a wider world as the incarnate Christ. This act of worship by the Magi, which corresponded to Simeon's blessing that this child Jesus would be 'a light for revelation to the Gentiles' (Luke 2:32), was one of the first indications that Jesus came for all people, of all nations, of all races, and that the work of God in the world would not be limited to only a few." – Dennis Bratcher
