₩ Worship Notes

◆The Season of Epiphany - Following the 12th day of Christmas, the church ushers in the Season of Epiphany. "As with most aspects of the Christian Year, Epiphany has theological significance. The term epiphany means 'to show' or 'to make known' or even 'to reveal.' The

Wise Men or Magi who brought gifts to the child Jesus were the first Gentiles to acknowledge Jesus as 'King' and so were the first to 'show' or 'reveal' Jesus to a wider world as the incarnate Christ. This act of worship by the Magi, which corresponded to Simeon's blessing that this child Jesus would be 'a light for revelation to the Gentiles' (Luke 2:32), was one of the first indications that Jesus came for all people, of all nations, of all races, and that the work of God in the world would not be limited to only a few." – Dennis Bratcher

The season of Epiphany ends with the Transfiguration of the Lord as found in Matthew 17:1-9. In 2023, Transfiguration Sundays falls on February 19.
