The meal looks superb – barbeque chicken breast, seasoned green beans. creamed potatoes. cornbread squares, peach and blueberry cobbler, and tea and water! And all of this for a suggested donation of \$8 (if that's too much just give what you can; if you can donate more than \$8 please do). Even though you will not be able to find a better meal in Ahoskie than what will be on offer Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023, in our church fellowship hall, don't come for the meal. Rather, come for the opportunity to engage with one another. Come to participate in God's church in action. We will gather around the tables together for a meal and then we will move upstairs to our sanctuary for Ash Wednesday worship.

The above exhortation is inspired by a recent happening. On Saturday, January 21, the West Point Cadet Chapel Choir led us in worship. I sense that the experience was meaningful for all that participated. It certainly was for me. I was caught off guard to discover that our time together in the fellowship hall, after the worship time in the sanctuary, was just as meaningful. I was not aware, until that Saturday evening, how much I missed our gatherings in the fellowship hall eating and talking and studying the Bible and praying. In fact, I was overcome with emotion when I reached out to shake a gentleman's hand. I do not know why exactly. I am still not sure what to make of it. Perhaps it was a combination of lingering covid trauma and a renewed awareness of how central the fellowship hall is to our Christian fellowship. The fellowship hall has been out of order for a long time first due to covid and second due to the now completed renovations. Yes, there was a period of renewed activity in between covid and the renovations. However, now it appears that the fellowship hall is open for uninterrupted human interaction over the long

haul. My pastoral gratitude extends to all the people who made our fellowship hall renovations such a huge success. The facility is just breathtaking.

Do you resonate with my January experience? It caught me by surprise indeed.

There was a meal, in our fellowship hall, on that Saturday night in January. I do not remember much about it. As I recall, sandwiches of some sort, chips, cookies, and drinks. I do not mean to minimize the meal – the effort to prepare it and the resources to pay for it. And we humans require nutrition. Furthermore, no one wants to encounter a "hangry" person in the church fellowship hall! Nonetheless, when I reflect on that first gathering in a longtime, in our newly renovated church fellowship hall, it is not the meal that stands out. Rather, it is the handshakes and the conversations and the embraces.

Please do come to our Ash Wednesday meal on February 22 at 6pm in our church fellowship hall. However, don't come for the meal as good as it will be. Come to participate in and witness the beautiful body of Christ in action.
