

## **₩** Worship Notes

◆The Christian Year – the church marks time differently than the secular world. We follow the Christian Year which begins with the Season of Advent four weeks prior to Christmas and ends with Christ the King Sunday on the Sunday prior to the beginning of Advent.

Today is Transfiguration Sunday, the final and climactic Sunday in the Epiphany season. On this Sunday, we celebrate Jesus' transfiguration on the mountain where Peter, John and James watched in amazement as the radiant Jesus spoke with the glorified Moses and Elijah. Jesus' identity as Son of God is revealed unmistakably when the Father physically glorifies Jesus and then announces, "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to Him!" And so, as we commemorate the glory and brilliance of our transfigured Lord, we are compelled to claim and proclaim Him Savior and Lord and follow wherever He leads.
