◆The Christian Year – the church marks time differently than the secular world. We follow the Christian Year which begins with the Season of Advent four weeks prior to Christmas and ends with Christ the King Sunday on the Sunday prior to the beginning of Advent.

Today we enter the final week of the Lenten Season known as Holy Week. Specifics about the week's observances are listed below. Except for Sanctuary Choir rehearsal, there are no activities on Wednesday; we do this to free up the week in the hope that you will reserve Thursday and Friday evenings for Holy Week worship. All worshipers are encouraged to participate in every worship service, choosing to follow Jesus every step of the way.
