

A Window on the Weeks Ahead

₩ Worship Notes

◆The Christian Year – the church marks time differently than the secular world. We follow the Christian Year which begins with the Season of Advent four weeks prior to Christmas and ends with Christ the King Sunday on the Sunday prior to the beginning of Advent.

Today the church begins a new season, ushered in by Pentecost Sunday. It is a day to celebrate hope, a hope evoked by the knowledge that God, through His Holy Spirit, is at work among His people. It is a celebration of newness, of recreation, of renewal of purpose, mission, and calling as God's people. It is a celebration of God's ongoing work in the world. Yet, it is also a recognition that His work is done through His people as He pours out His presence upon them.

The word "Pentecost" means "fiftieth" and refers to the fiftieth day. In most Christian traditions, Pentecost Sunday occurs 50 days following Easter Sunday. The color for Pentecost Sunday is red, symbolizing both the fire of Pentecost as well as the apostles and early followers of Jesus who were gathered in the Upper Room for the empowerment from God to proclaim the Gospel throughout the world.
