Items Needed:

- Peanut butter (*5 pts*)
- Canned spaghetti sauce (*traditional or meat*) (*4 pts*)
- Canned fruit (*3 pts*)
- Canned milk (*evaporated*) (*2 pts*)
- Ketchup (*5 pts*)
- Chili sauce (*3 pts*)
- Vienna sausages (*3 pts*)

Note: Pop-top cans are preferred for easier access and distribution and add an additional point to each item.
