This will be the first of our quarterly business meetings, scheduled for Wednesday, May 13, 2026, at 6:30 pm in the church fellowship hall. During this meeting, we will discuss a proposed amendment to the church By-Laws, specifically Article X, Section 1(A), which addresses the process for the election of a pastor. After discussion, a church vote on this proposed by-law amendment will be held at the business meeting.

Another matter of business will be the unanimous recommendation from the Deacons to reinstate the prior Pastor Search Committee. After discussion, a church vote to reinstate this committee will be held.

Glasgow preached as a guest on April 12, 2026, and officially began his duties as Interim Pastor on April 16, 2026. Details regarding his employment will be shared at the upcoming business meeting.
