Follow the instructions below to download the app.

1. Open your device's app store:
 - For Apple devices (iPhone, iPad), open the App Store.
 - For Android devices, open the Google Play Store.
2. Search for the app:
 - Search for "Instant Church Directory" in the app store's search bar.
3. Download and install:
 - Locate the Instant Church Directory app (icon is a green church).
 - Tap the "Get" (or similar) button to download and install the app.
4. Open the app:
 - Once installed, you can open the app.
5. Sign in:
 - You will need to sign in using the email address your church has on file for you and follow the instructions to confirm your login.
 - If you are using a shared or public device, remember to sign out when you are finished.

1. Visit www.instantchurchdirectory.com
2. Click on Member Sign In
3. Log in with the email address you provided to the office.
4. You will receive an email, follow the steps enclosed.
