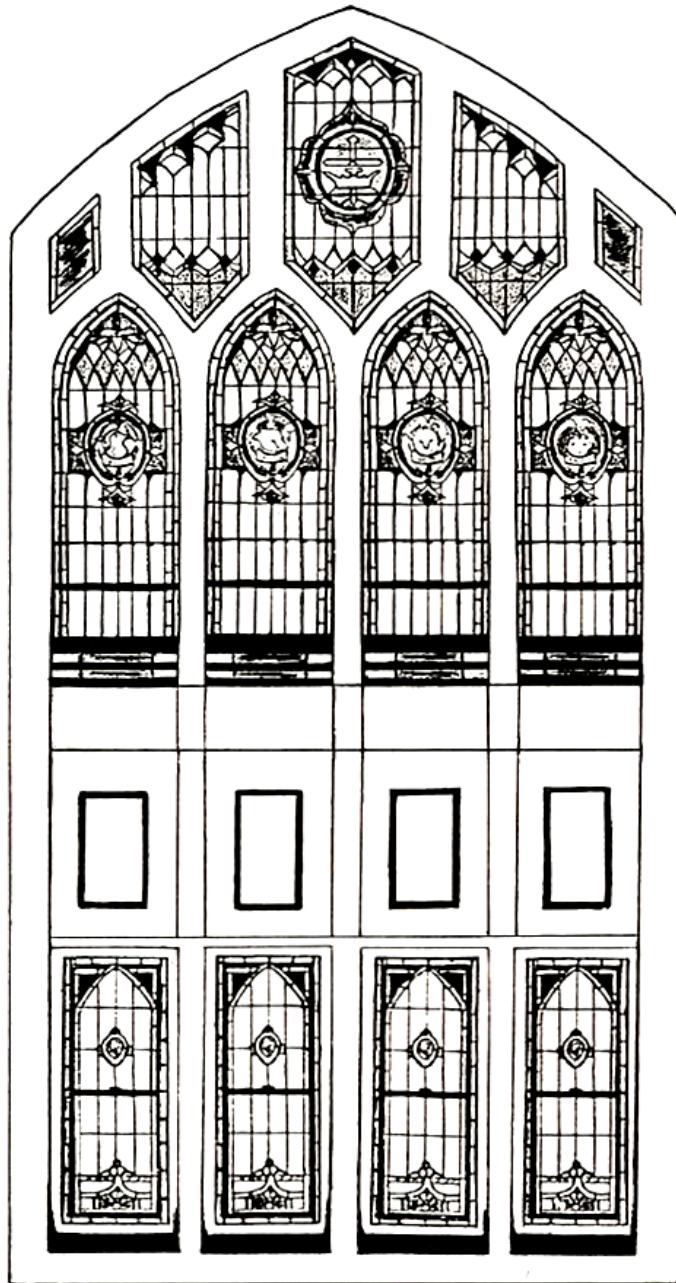

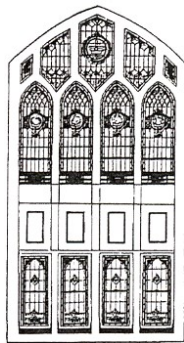

# Out of the Depths I Cry to You



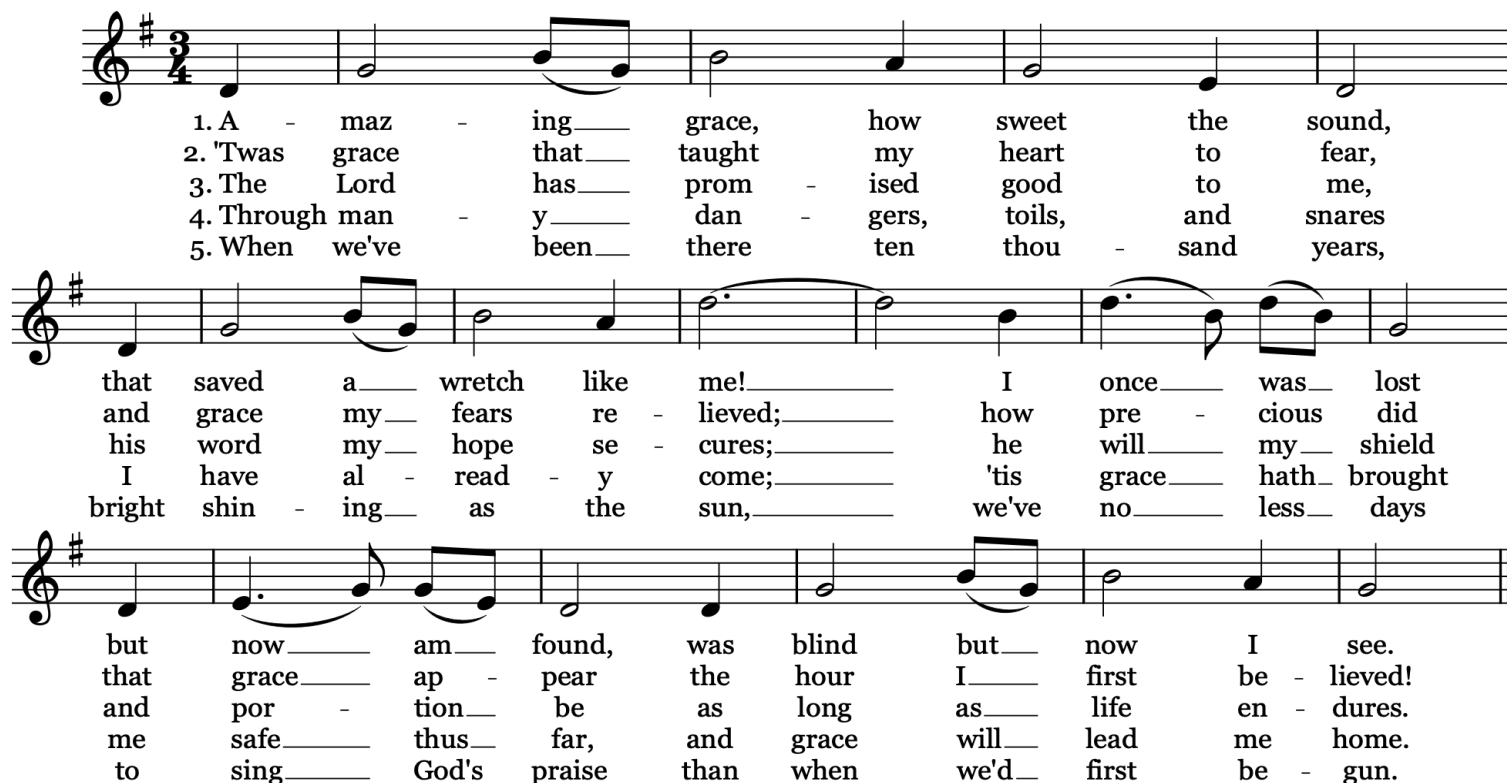
1. Out of the depths I cry to You; O Lord, come hear my voice!
